Seminarians to the Marist Places of Origin



After a busy and intense Summer program, the full community of *Casa di Maria*—the international theologate in Rome—joined together in La Neylière for a one week retreat preached by former superior general Fr Joaquín Fernández. The week before the retreat, the seniors among them continued their time of pilgrimage, with a visit of the Marist places of Origin in France under the guidance of Fr Jean Vienne (M). In the mean time the whole group has returned home to Rome, where they have just started the new academic year. This year the formation team is joined by Fr Denis Revi (O), who has completed the training of formation program in Rome in July.
