



## The Decease of Fr Rafaele Qalovi

The members and staff of the General House community are particularly saddened and are mourning for the decease of Fr Rafa Qalovi this morning in the Presbytery of Nadi, Fiji.

Rafa was born in 1957 in Levuka, Fiji and made his first profession in 1979. After his ordination in 1984 he has spent many years in teaching, until he became councilor of the Oceania Province in 2000. At the General Chapter of 2001 he was elected general assistant. He spent 8 years in Rome at the general house with the administration of Fr Jan Hulshof. In 2009 he went back to Fiji where he worked in the Marist Training Centre of Tutu and these last two years in Nadi, where he was parish priest. Rafa has been ill for many years, and has been accompanied by the loving care of his confreres and family, particularly in these last difficult months. Rest in Peace dear Fr Rafa!


## “Jean-Claude Colin, a Descriptive Chronology of his life” is available online
