AFTER CYCLONE "WINSTON"

Monster Cyclone Winston has left a massive trail of destruction in many parts of Fiji. Fortunately all confreres are safe and well, but the cyclone has caused much damage to buildings and crops. Many people died, and others have lost all their properties. Suva was not severely hit by the cyclone, but many other parts of the region were. The communities where confreres are ministering have suffered severe damage to their buildings: the schools including dormitories and workshops, churches, training blocks; and also to the crops, including an enormous number of coconut trees. The Tutu Rural Training Centre in Taveuni was severely hit, with its 22 buildings completely or partially destroyed, as well as 106.000 kava plants and 22.000 dalo plants. Also St John's college in Cawaci, Ovalau had a huge damage to almost all of its buildings.

All confreres in Fiji are very grateful for the prayers offered and the many messages of support from all parts of the world.
