YOUNG MARISTS WORKSHOP IN SUVA

Twelve Marist priests from the Oceania Province, who were ordained in the last 5 years, came together in Suva for a workshop called “Just Ministry”, facilitated by Fr Soane ‘Ahohako. The tasks of the workshop, as strongly encouraged by the Superior General, was “to develop the formation of their missionary hearts, heads, and imitations” (ARC, 2018), and “to enable them to reflect on their experiences and to share their concerns and joys with their peers” (PC 2017). The workshop was also part of the efforts to strive for higher professionalism among the confreres (GC 2017).
