for the Cause Jean Claude Colin, to the Congregation for the Causes of Saints. Fr Peyret was welcomed at the General House where he met the Superior General and other members of the GA and the General House community. He also had a meeting with our postulator for the Cause – Fr Carlo Maria Schianchi, who will take up the work to be done with the Vatican.
